Math Descriptions

For the Love of Math, Part 1: Grades 3-4 (Mrs. Bontje & Mr. Sprau)

This class, for beginners or those who struggle with problem solving, is a continuation of the winter session. Students who participated in winter are encouraged to continue with the spring session. We will continue to focus on making math interesting and fun on Thursday afternoons. Thursdays, 3:30-4:30 p.m.

For the Love of Math, Part 2: Grades 3-4 (Mr. Sprau & Mrs. Bontje) – Now on Wednesdays

This class, offering a more systematic study of problem solving strategies, is a continuation of the winter session. Students who participated in winter are encouraged to continue with the spring session. Students should be fluent in all areas of advanced whole number computation, as well as have a foundation in fraction and decimal concepts to attend this class. **Please note change of day:** Wednesdays, 3:30-4:30 p.m.

For the Love of Math, Part 3 (Mrs. Gregory)

This class combines math enrichment activities with focused lessons in problem solving strategies for students who have exposure to pre-algebra topics. Thursdays, 3:30-4:30 p.m.

Intermediate Math Team Practice (Mr. Debelak)

Students will learn strategies for solving complex problems in algebra, geometry, counting and probability, number theory, and percent/proportions. Students in grades 5-8 with a strong background in pre-algebra topics are welcome. Tuesdays, 3:30-4:30 p.m.

Advanced Math Team Practice (Mr. Debelak)

This is a continuation of Intermediate Team Practice. Students in grades 6-8 will need a working knowledge of algebra and a good foundation in geometry. Thursdays, 3:30-4:30 p.m. There will be an extra session from 4:30-5 p.m. for students hoping to compete at a high level in math contests.
